

Politics – Europe’s future and the contribution of faith communities, **Part 2**

Our speaker for this session was **Terry Wynn**, a former senior MEP¹, President of European Parliament’s Budget Committee. Terry took time to respond to Monday’s General Session by Jorge César das Neves. He also shared his perspective and analysis powerfully on Europe’s future and the contribution of faith communities, inspired by his personal experience as a believer in politics.
